Eugene outlined the city's infrastructure plans regarding the Boardwalk and Fraser River projects. There is a three-year planning cycle. Starting in 2015 projects and budgets are set. Inspection of sub-structures, decking, railings etc. are completed during a 5-year program. The engineering department then assigns projects on a case-by-case basis. The replacement of the Boardwalk has moved to the top of the list. A lot of work has been done between the Discovery Center and the new playground. There are some issues with work needed on the boardwalk that is owned by the businesses at the Quay.

Some projects are on hold while the new buildings are under construction. They include improving the pedestrian access to the Quay, new traffic lights on Carnarvon, and access points too Pier Park. Following Eugene's presentation concerns were raised about the progress on issues that have been raised. Painting the railings was mentioned. This is waiting for the weather to improve.
